Nashua Valley Railroad Association Membership Process

- 1. Applicants shall be sponsored by a member of the Association in good standing.
- 2. Application submissions require a non-refundable deposit of \$20.00. Checks can be made payable to NVRRA.
- 3. The Senior Applicant agrees to serve a trial period which will consist of:
 - a. 6 in person visits to the Association's quarters within a period not exceeding 4 months.
 - b. Attendance at a minimum of 1 business meeting, remotely or in person. Attending the meeting at which the candidate will be considered for membership will satisfy this requirement.

Exception: Prior members who resigned in good standing may be exempted by the Board of Directors from serving an additional trial period.

- 4. The Associate Applicant trial period will consist of having their name read into two consecutive monthly business meetings.
- 5. Pending applications will be kept in an accessible location within the Association's quarters for easy access to record attendance.
- Upon successful completion of the trial period, the application will be brought before the general membership to be voted on pursuant to the Association's by-laws.
- 7. All senior members in good standing with at least 6 months of active service shall have unlimited access to the Association quarters and facilities. Senior members with fewer than 6 months of service shall have access to the quarters and facilities only during scheduled meetings or in the presence of a senior member who has unlimited rights and privileges.
